
S1 Bridging Programme

Appended Notes – Guidelines to Parents in case of Bad Weather:**Outdoor Activities (example: Camping)**

- ✧ For whole day activity, at 06:30 of the activity day if Education Bureau announcement on school closure, tropical cyclone warning signal No.1 or above, any rainstorm warning signal, any flooding or landslide warning signal, or air pollution index reaching 200 or above is in effect, the activity will be cancelled. It is not necessary for the student to report at the gathering place.
- ✧ For afternoon activity, at 12:00 of the activity day if Education Bureau announcement on school closure, tropical cyclone warning signal No.1 or above, any rainstorm warning signal, any flooding or landslide warning signal, or air pollution index reaching 200 or above is in effect, the activity will be cancelled. It is not necessary for the student to report at the gathering place.

Indoor Activities (example: Orientation Day)

- ✧ For whole day activity, at 06:30 of the activity day if Education Bureau announcement on school closure, tropical cyclone warning signal No.3 or above, or a red/black rainstorm warning signal is still in effect, the activity will be cancelled. It is not necessary for the student to report at the gathering place.
- ✧ For afternoon activity, at 12:00 of the activity day if Education Bureau announcement on school closure, tropical cyclone warning signal No.3 or above, or a red/black rainstorm warning signal is still in effect, the activity will be cancelled. It is not necessary for the student to report at the gathering place.

All absentees need to submit the Leave Application letter on or before 18/07. Reasons of absence have to be clearly stated. In the event of public announcements by the EDB of school closure due to the adverse weather conditions, the tests will be postponed to Wed, 13/07. Parents are not required to accompany the students to attend the test.
